Vineyard description:

This 700 acre vineyard is on the eastern edge of Russian River Valley. Due to its expansive acreage and highly diverse topography, 250 acres were carefully selected for growing premium wine grapes. Our pinot noir comes from two different blocks on the property. All of our clones are blanketed by the early morning coastal fog and bask in the warm afternoon sun.

Winemaker notes:

This Russian River Pinot is a blend of three different clones, each of which adds to the elegance and complexity. Using traditional Burgundian methods, this wine was fermented using 25% whole cluster and a native Burgundian yeast. The nose has hints of vanilla, sage, cherry and spice with a notable minerality. This wine is a classic Russian River Pinot in character and can be paired with a wide variety of dishes.
