Vineyard Description:

Mountainview Ranch is located at 900 ft. elevation on a terraced vineyard on Bradford Mountain. Because of the true steepness of this vineyard, it brings a huge amount of structure and acidity. Planted to clone 337, this block yielded just 2.1 tons per acre in 2007.

Winemaker Notes:

Fermented in all new French oak, this classic Cabernet boasts flavors of ripe cherry, anise, and black currant, has excellent balance and complexity, supple texture, ripe tannins, and a lush full bodied finish. Drinks great now, but can be cellared for the next 10 years.
