Vineyard Description:

The Kokomo Cuvée is a unique blend of vineyards and varietals from across Sonoma County. Sonoma County is quickly becoming recognized as one of the premier wine grape regions of the world. Stemming from its close proximity to the coast, the county has very diverse micro-climates and a wide range of soil types. We scour the county for vineyards of distinction to showcase the versatility of the area.

Winemaker Notes:

Dry Creek Valley Merlot and Cabernet predominate in this wine showcasing the Bordeaux side of this blend. Carignan, Petite Sirah, and a touch of Syrah highlight the Rhone varietals and offer a distinct Rhone character, and a twist of Dry Creek Valley from, of course, Zinfandel.

Complex, yet balanced with layers and layers of flavors and a persistent finish.

Barrel aging 90% French, 10% American/30% new oak.
