Vineyard Description:

Timber Crest Vineyards is located on Dry Creek's world renowned bench land on the east side of the valley. Dry Creek Valley is known for its outstanding quality of fruit, primarily Zinfandel. This Zinfandel was grown in a block of 35 year old vines that are trellised in a bi-lateral cordon on a west facing bench. It is an old clone farmed by Randy Peters. The vineyard itself is owned by Ruth and Ronald Waltenspiel, who have been farming hundreds of Dry Creek Valley acres for over 50 years.

Winemaker Notes:

This Zinfandel is ripe and jammy, with blackberry and toasty sage aromas and soft cherry, pepper and vanilla flavors. This wine would be best paired with your favorite bbq'd steak, chili con carne or grilled pork chops.
