Vineyard Description:

This 100 acre Timber Crest vineyard is located off Dry Creek Road, on the valley floor. The sauvignon blanc actually borders the Dry Creek. The soil composition of this vineyard is Yolo Sandy Loam, the clone is 01EH. Our particular block was farmed so that there was an extensive amount of leaf pull above the fruit zone to filter in plenty of sunlight to the cluster.

Winemaker Notes:

This Sauvignon Blanc was made in a traditional style to showcase more of the tropical nature of the varietal. We achieved this by letting the fruit develop more maturity by exposing the clusters to sunlight on the vine. We fermented 100% of this wine in stainless steel at 50°. With aromas of pear, apricot, guava and a hint of sweet grass. The palate showcases rich & round notes of citrus finish with vibrant balanced acidity.
